Voters Service: The newspaper will be thanked for their cooperation in printing questions and candidates' answers. The chairman helped in getting one absentee ballot.

Mrs. Protzman moved that \$2 bill for making charts for revenue be paid. CARRIED. Workshops on Foreign Policy and Public Health services in Decatur and Macon County will start after the first of the year. Study of county government will continue to meet until the holidays.

Mrs. Reeder gave an excellent talk on WCIA's telecourse on Political Parties.

Membership: Mrs. Hurst reported 4 new members and 1 transfer. There will be an orientation meeting for new and old members December 8 at 8 p.m. A paid membership list, in the form of a handy booklet containing pertinent information about the League will be distributed soon.

It was suggested that the bulletin be printed on standard size paper and also have a title.

Mrs. Peterson resigned as Program Chairman.

Mrs. Doubleday asked us to think of state agenda items to be decided on next month.

The meeting adjourned at 2:45.
